Despite the the result of the Brexit vote the Government has announced that the UK's implementation of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) will go ahead. This is the biggest change in data protection law for 20 years. A lot of work needs to be done now before GDPR comes into force on 25th May 2018.

All of the main topics are covered – changes to consent and privacy notices, controls on profiling, mandatory breach reporting, penalties, and the right to be forgotten.
